Since the Fall of 2016, I have served as a Broadcast and Digital Journalism Professor of Practice at the S.I. Newhouse School, Syracuse University. My duties include teaching at least three classes per semester, teaching SUmmer college, high school students, mentoring well over 100 Newhouse students and alumni, and teaching my skill set to master's students. I also help students with internships and jobs through numerous industry contacts.
